West Bath Sues RSU1 and Arrowsic

From the Town Select Board

West Bath is suing RSU1, Bath, Woolwich and Arrowsic to recover about \$1.9 million that they claim was overpaid. The suit alleges that the City of Bath acted to persuade the RSU to use an allocation formula that benefitted Bath to the detriment of West Bath and Phippsburg or that Bath did so as the result of a mistake. The suit also names the Town of Arrowsic for having benefitted from underpayments as a result of the allocation formula that was applied between 2008 and 2012. West Bath is seeking compensation from our Town for \$183,526, which is the amount they claim we underpaid the RSU during those years.

RSU1 and the City of Bath have contracted attorneys who will be taking the lead in defending the suit. At an emergency meeting on January 24, the Town Select Board chose a lawyer to represent us in this matter. We will keep residents informed as the case develops. We also expect to convene a special meeting sometime in the next few months to answer questions about the lawsuit, its implications for the Town and the actions we are taking to respond.


