Chris Brett (PB) arrived early to drop off meeting minutes before having to excuse himself from the meeting.

7:03 p.m. Roger called the meeting to order.

Dec 2, 2012 Site Walk Meeting Minutes—Copies of previously approved meeting minutes were handed out.

Dec. 3, 2013 Meeting Minutes-- Were handed out for review. A few small corrections were noted. Andrea moved to accept the notes with corrections. Geoffrey seconded, and all voted in favor.

Nov. 5, 2012 Meeting Minutes—Were handed out for review. Several corrections and clarifications were made. Don moved to accept the notes with corrections. Jennifer seconded, and all voted in favor.

New "Town of Arrowsic Zoning Ordinance" booklets were handed out to Board Members (as amended June 13, 2012). A question was raised as to whether the town website is up to date with the amendments so that the public has electronic access to that information.

Mike opened up a discussion of "orthoimagery" and shared a booklet titled "Maine Geolibrary Orthoimagery Program". The program is spearheaded by the state, and provides an overhead view of Maine, including each county & town. Sagadahoc County will be flown over & new imagery created in the Spring of 2013. There is an option available to the Town of Arrowsic for approximately \$2,000.00 to be paid for an upgrade of the imagery to a higher resolution. There was discussion as to the potential value in paying for the upgrade to assist in real estate tax assessment, codes enforcement, plus planning by the Conservation Commission, the Road Commission, the Fire Dept., and perhaps residents as well. Any decision to upgrade is likely under the jurisdiction of the Town Selectmen, so discussion was just that. Mike provided a helpful demonstration of the mapping software on a town hall computer.

Roger asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Geoffrey so moved. Don seconded, and all voted in favor. The meeting adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
