Michael Kreindler, CEO

Michael requested an increase in building permits to \$0.20 per square foot. The Board took this under advisement.

Concerning the Mill Island code violations matter Michael will draft a letter to be reviewed by the Town's attorney then brought to the Board for approval. He also asked the Board to begin a search for a successor.

Candidates for Conservation Commission

Karin Dowell expressed her interest in joining the Conservation Commission. She was informed that the Board will see two other candidates before making a decision.

Revaluation next steps

The Board reviewed the letter to be sent to property owners, to be mailed August 3, and agreed on dates for appeal hearings.

Flooded basement in Town Hall

Sheila reported on the flooding of the basement due to corrosion in the pressure tank. This was repaired by Turnbull plumber.

An amended policy statement, covering both Town Hall and the Fire Station, will be reviewed at the next meeting.
