## ARROWSIC CONSERVATION COMMMISSION MINUTES April 17, 2018

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 5:03PM
- 2. The minutes of the March 20, 2018 meeting were accepted as amended.
- 3. The Commission attended to the planning details for Saturday's Annual Roadside Clean-up.
- 4. Susan and Karen reported on the storm damage findings. It was decided to meet Saturday April 28<sup>th</sup> at 1PM to cut a 6 foot wide access path and to add up hill swales to the Conservation Area trail. Phine has been contacted by a resident that wants to cut the two large oaks up for personal firewood. It was decided to let the Select Board respond as it is a town resource and firewood has been used for General Assistance in the past.
- 5. The alewife monitoring trap will be going in this Thursday.
- 6. We will continue to check the Stewardship guide for any broken links and report back to Paul who will collate and have someone with the publishing program In-Design make the corrections.
- 7. The Select Board shared that there are water front access grant monies available again this year.
- 8. There is a meeting at the Patten Free Library on April 25<sup>th</sup> regarding Sea Level Rise Preparations.
- 9. The Commission volunteered Noreen to chair next month's meeting and agreed to collectively step up if she is unable.
- 10. Natures Notes: Peregrine Falcons were noticed flying about. Sewall Pond ice-out was April 1<sup>st</sup>. The osprey are back. Wood frogs, peepers, and barred owls have been heard. Colt foot, a ground hog, flickers, and sap suckers have been seen.
- 11. Other: Paul will check on the Coast Guard Light Keeper's house again as town access. The mark-up copy of the Comprehensive Plan is being passed around among members.
- 12. May 15th is the next meeting, at 5PM at the Arrowsic Town Hall.
- 13. The meeting was adjourned at 5:57 PM.
