- 8. The state has been declared drought free since the last snow storm. The Commission has decided to continue with the well head survey. It will be sent out with the Annual Report in May. Clarke expects the website to up and running by then, so that, those who prefer will be able to respond on-line.
- 9. Road side clean-up was discussed. Phine will speak to the Recycling committee about the Recycling Committee becoming the coordinating committee.
- 10. The Conservation Consortium Committee met and the next meeting is March 14th at the Phippsburg Town Hall.
- 11. Nature's Notes: Paul reports seeing large red squirrel middens in Georgetown. Clarke is not seeing as much ice in the river as in years past. There has been a king fisher on the power lines at the culvert just south of Fisher Eddy the past several mornings. Noreen has 5-6 blue birds that showed up at her house starting around the 23d or 24th.
