- 5. We agreed to check the Stewardship guide for any broken links and report back.

- 7. Phine asked that each member think about family friendly activities the Commission might bring to the Fall Festival.
- 8. Susan and Karen will scout the Conservation Area and determine a plan of action for the storm clean up.
- 9. The Commission will review the Comprehensive Plan's charge to the Conservation Commission.
- 10. Natures Notes: Susan saw 4 bluebirds today at her feeder and Noreen's woodcock were spending a lot of time around the bare ground prior to the last snow storm. There has been a small flock of turkeys around as well as a good size herd of deer (12+) and no pine siskins, redpolls and winter buntings were seen this year.
- 11. April 17th is the next meeting, at 5PM at the Arrowsic Town Hall.
- 12. The meeting was adjourned at 5:58 PM.
