1. Approve last meeting minutes.

Camille circulated the minutes from the last meeting and David & Anita, who attended the last meeting, approved the minutes. **David agreed to obtain a binder and submit the the notes** from the committee meetings in the binder and file the binder at the Arrowsic Town Hall.

2. Create a meeting schedule to post for the public.

Bill Savedof impressed upon the Committee that legally the Committee is obligated to post Committee meeting dates and times ahead of the actual meeting for the public. At this meeting it was agreed that the Committee would address to what degree the Committee had to account for the students in the district and if it was a priority to have a formal versus informal structure to review the student list from RSU1 going forward. - Anita suggested that the Committee identify community events where the Committee may have a stake and be able to represent the Town to the public and interact with families. Potential "back to school BBQ" and "play night" were discussed.
