WOOD CHIPS Karen will ask one of the many Asplundt crews presently on the island if we can have a truckload or two of chips delivered to the conservation area for spreading later in the season. It was noted that some of the water bars have rotted, and the layer of chips is wearing thin.


DOGS ON LEASH SIGN is not yet available. Nancy is not present to report on progress, but Karen noted that she hasn't received anything to be painted yet.

NON NATIVE INVASIVES Karen asked if a letter with the list of non-native invasives had been sent to the planning board. It has not. Phine will draft a letter.

WIND POWER Karen reported that Jeremy Blaiklock is preparing an ordinance to allow wind power towers, taking into consideration noise beyond property line, fall circumference of the tower, and flicker screening for neighbors.

The meeting adjourned at 7:50, to inspect two mystery trees; one on Spinney Mill Road (possibly *Acer Negundo*), and the other on the Blaiklock property (*Acer campestre*, we think).
