Minutes, August 10, 2021

The meeting was opened at 6.02 pm.

The agenda was approved.

The minutes for July 27, 2021 were approved.

The Treasurer's Warrant #3 for \$51,908.01 was approved.

Insurance: An invoice has been received from F.A. Peabody, but not the policy. Until this is received we cannot confirm to MMA that the new policy covers Broadband allowing MMA to release us from the MMA Property and Casualty contract.

Concerns about AirBnB rentals were discussed. It was agreed that there are no prohibitions in Arrowsic ordinances that would cover this.

Sheila passed on information about the T-Mobile small towns grant program and an approach by Net Energy Billing.
