8/24/15

Warrant & Treasurers Report:

Warrant # 4 (\$5,333.31) Motion made to approve, all in favor.

Town Clerk's Report:

Paul Schlein asked the clerk to find out when the final decision of the Preble Point issue would be in the Selectmen's minutes. Bill noted that in our last communication with the landowners, Sukey had expressly stated that they should make no modifications to Town property. We have not heard anything from them since.

A resident had a question regarding a sub-standard property. The Board recommended that the owner speak to Michael Kreindler, the Code Enforcement Officer.

Linda had asked the Select Board to proof read the Town Meeting Minutes, the Board reported that all seem to be in order. Linda will place a copy of the minutes in the Selectmen's binder as well as in the file.

Update on Town Clerk Search:

A new town clerk has not yet been found. The Select Board will continue the search.

Update Mini-pumper pump estimate:

Michael checked with a Reliance Equipment in Vassalboro about an estimate on repairing the mini-pumper. The Select Board will discuss this information with the Fire Chief.

Malcolm Persen has asked to meet with the Select Board in September to present the current findings of the Committee. The Board will put him on the agenda or schedule a special meeting.

New Business:

Bill noted that the RSU1 meeting scheduled for 8/27 has been postponed.

Bill received an email from a resident concerned about Lyme Disease, asking if the Town should do more about it. Bill put him in contact with Kathleen Mary, our Local Health Officer (LHO), who had already put this on her agenda to discuss with other LHOs in September. He felt the issue was in good hands. Based on email exchanges, he expects that there will be two articles in the November *Arrow* about the issue.

Old Business:

The Select Board discussed inconsistencies in the procedures for reimbursing homeowners for the septic disposal fees. Bill will draft a policy that reflects the Select Board discussions and will work with Paul Kalkstein to have a reimbursement request form posted on the website and available at Town Hall. He said he would also put an article about the policy in the next issue of *The Arrow*.

Bill reminded the Select Board that he would like to schedule a discussion of town properties for later this year.
