## Arrowsic Broadband Authority (ABA) update – Don Kornrumpf, Vince Capone, & Don Hudson:

- The regular weekly meeting with Hawkeye occurred today. They have only a few more drops to complete, which Hawkeye/Axiom seem willing to complete over time.
- ABA will try to accommodate Axiom's added cost of the extra drops over the budgeted 165 planned compared to an expected 195-200 actual drops.
- After Axiom's final billing, ABA is seeking to reconcile ABA's budget with Maine Connectivity Authority (MCA). ABA continues to chase MCA for closing.
- MCA wants to publicize the Arrowsic broadband installation process on its PR media. Interviews and filming will be done soon in Arrowsic. ABA has lined up a number of locals to be interviewed.
- The ABA recommends self-insuring due to the terms of the PURMA insurance and estimates of the range of potential storm damage. A formal recommendation will be presented at the June 10<sup>th</sup> Select Board meeting.

- Arrowsic Recycling & Solid Waste Committee (ARSWC) is looking for another member.
- Tom Spear, editor of The Arrow, will be moving to Brunswick in August. An editor of The Arrow.

## Other business:

 A project leader for the Maine Infrastructure Adaption Fund (MIAF) grant is needed. Jack Witham was approved on a motion by Jennifer seconded by DeeDee. The purpose of the grant is to adapt critical infrastructure—such as areas on Rt. 127 and Spinney Mill Road that flood regularly—to reduce vulnerability to climate change.
