1) Introductions [All]

- a) Andrew accountant with extensive non-profit funding experience

2) Review of ARC mission and objectives

- d) Priorities and open discussion Jerry suggested that most Arrowsic residents would be most motivated to support initiatives to protect Roads, Water, and Power. Members agreed that funding for other ARC efforts (e.g., those to protect and conserve wetlands and fragile island ecosystems at risk from flooding, drought, and potential fires, may require community education and could be done in parallel.

3) Community Action Grant update

- a) Open discussion on fundraising, potential projects and collaborators, how to use the CAP to help us decide next steps for applying.
- b) Important Grant Details. Min CAG award: \$5K, Max award: \$75K. Submission deadline is December 17 at 5 PM. Jody will be traveling in December, so the ACR team needs to prepare the grant and submit in her absence
- c) An Arrowsic **private well study** may be a good potential focus as Arrowsic residents rely on well water. The money could fund a consultant to perform the study. Side note: We also discussed the well pump at the town hall and that it

- might be an easy win to take the necessary action (water tests, etc) to make it an available resource again.
- d) We discussed whether we may want to submit a joint grant with another town (e.g., Phippsburg, Georgetown, Woolwich, etc.) to be eligible for group funding. This would require coordination and collaboration that may be challenging to get agreement on given the short deadline.

4) Update on current activities

- a) Arrowsic Fire Dept. Grants
 - i) <u>Firehouse Subs:</u> ~ \$35,000 for new turnout gear
 - ii) <u>Stephen & Tabitha King Foundation</u>: \$20,000 for specialized washer & drying cabinet.
- b) <u>Phippsburg</u>: They got a small grant from the Casco Bay Estuary Partnership to hire someone to work on resilience. The person hired will have availability if we need help. Interested in collaborating but not sure how.
- c) Georgetown: reached out but no response yet. Resilience cmte in transition
- d) Woolwich: Jody having coffee with David Berndtson (<u>dberndtson@gmri.org</u>) on Saturday at 9:45 to chat about possible collaborations & share info.
- e) <u>Westport</u>: Jody reached out to Dennis Dunbar about getting a copy of their well study. Will send along when it's done. Their successful grant with the partnership is in the google docs.
- f) Maine Geological Survey: Jody and Karin Statdler have a phone meeting scheduled for October 15 at 9 am with state geologist Jessica Meeks (see <u>Bangor Daily News article here</u>) to discuss possible collaboration and advice on what type of activities to consider for our grant..
