- Commitment: Commitment occurred last week. Some issues with some of the exemptions, etc. Select Board members signed Certificate of Assessment.
- MDOT Installation of No Parking Signs on Rte 127-Bob Ater: Revisiting the parking issue on 127 across from Sewall Pond; a few boulders have been installed to remove erosion. Suggests the town to consider an ordinance that does not allow parking on rt. 127, North, South, East, and West. No parking on both sides. After town passes ordinance, the state will install it as a commissioner's record item. The MDOT would put in signs, but the town would be responsible for maintenance. Importance of having a plan for what the parking should be. Necessity for public meeting to get input before the ordinance is proposed. Will include consideration of no overnight parking in ordinance. Draft of proposed ordinance will be presented to Select Board.
