- Energy Efficiency Project: Nick Stoneman

- 1) Potential Solar Install: Donation from the Karhls will provide funding for a solar array on the fire station roof. Total cost is about \$35,000 but with regulations and rebates, will cost roughly \$21,000. Donor will cover difference between Kahrl's donation and \$21, 000. Twenty-seven panel system will fit on the Fire Station roof. By May 1, we need deposit for contract; the work all needs to be done by year end to get rebates. Potential for some lag in rebates but have cushion to handle it. Jennifer motioned to authorize proposed installation of solar panels on the roof of the fire station; DeeDee seconded; all approved.
 - 2) Grant for energy efficiency funding: Grant could be for a variety of things--heat pumps, window efficiency, vapor barriers. It is unclear whether a solar battery/generator could be included. There is a necessity to establish priorities: basement is first priority for this building; better ceiling and windows next; then heat pumps become more viable. \$75,000 grant could handle the basement and heat pumps.
- Annual Report
 - 1) Kathy Roy asked for increase in scholarships provided to Arrowsic students: asking to increase scholarship level to \$3,000. It will be part of the upcoming language for that article.
 - 2) Memorial Day Select Board Meeting will be on Wednesday, May 27
 - 3) Wednesday, April 15, 2:00 PM for budget/warrant meeting at Town Hall.
 - Stafford Lane Paving
 - 1) Michael Kreindler asked to use gravel removed for Stafford Lane Paving to be used for increasing parking at Fire Station. It would also require removal of several trees. Select Board asked for clearer sense of costs involved.
 - Request for town potluck before the town meeting was discussed and agreed to.
