 - To register your dogs. All dogs over the age of six months are required to be licensed each year in the town where they reside.

- Contact our Codes Officer, Mike Field, at mike.field@arrowsic.org, **before** starting any improvements such as clearing vegetation, construction, road building, or starting a home business. We have ordinances in place to protect the environment and public health and to make it easier to live with your neighbors. Mike is available to help you realize your goals in ways that comply with ordinances and meet our common interests. The Town's ordinances can be found at the Town website.
- Contact our Local Health Officer (LHO), Mike Field at mike.field@arrowsic.org, if you have any concerns about health or environmental risks. Mike is responsible for identifying and/or responding to such risks faced by individuals and the community.

 - Volunteer: Arrowsic is your Town. We rely upon volunteers. Contact any committee or Town official to find out how you can play a role. Committee descriptions and contact information can be found online at www.arrowsic.org.

- For Emergency Services make sure that your house can be reached by a large fire truck and ambulance by doing appropriate vegetation clearing, snow removal, and driveway maintenance. Mark your driveway with reflective address numbers visible from the road in both directions to help responders find you in an emergency.
- Trash, recycling, and composting:
 - The Town offers curbside trash and recycling pickup year-round, and we ask that you follow the schedule and guidelines posted on the Town website.
 - Please attach a yellow recycling sticker (enclosed) to all recycling containers.
 - The Arrowsic Recycling and Solid Waste Committee (ARSWC) helps residents understand the importance of recycling and composting our waste, while minimizing the amount of trash and hazardous materials that still end up in our landfills and incinerators—at a higher cost to the Town and the environment.
 - Arrowsic has one of the highest recycling rates in the state, and a high rate of backyard composting, as well. Please join us in our commitment to maintaining a healthy, beautiful community for all of our residents to enjoy!

- To help members of our community use resources thoughtfully, co-habit with all resident species and engage in best management practices on their property, The Arrowsic Conservation Commission has put together a *Stewardship Guide to Caring for Our Land and Water*.  - Arrowsic residents participate in school choice within the RSU 1 district for students in kindergarten through twelfth grade, with busing available to Woolwich and Bath school locations
